

PUBLIC POLICY: WIOA AMENDMENT 20-06

WORKFORCE INNOVATION AND OPPORTUNITY ACT (WIOA)

I. SUBJECT:

First Amendment Public Policy on the criteria for determining eligibility for Youth, Adults, and Dislocated Workers.

II. BACKGROUND:

The Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) promotes activities for the development of skills and abilities for youth by offering courses and workshops based on their knowledge, providing them with the opportunity to experience a friendly work environment where they can develop skills, acquire knowledge, improve weaknesses, and eliminate barriers that may limit their success in entering the workforce.

III. PURPOSE OF THE AMENDMENT:

Considering the importance of complying with the requirements of the Selective Service Law, it is necessary to amend Public Policy 20-06 to add the requirement of this criterion for a WIOA participant who reaches the age of 18 while active in the program.

IV. AMENDED PART:


Requirements for compliance with Selective Service registration:

If a male participant turns 18 while participating in any applicable activity, registration with the Selective Service must be completed no later than 30 days after turning 18 to continue receiving services funded by WIOA. If a male under 26 years of age refuses to register with the Selective Service, services funded by Title I funds of WIOA must be suspended until registration occurs.

V. EFFECTIVENESS

This Public Policy shall take effect immediately upon approval by the Local Board. All other provisions of the Work Experience Public Policy remain unchanged and in effect.
